

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

Care counselling

People seeking advice and their relatives can can turn to the care counselling service with any questions about care – regardless of which health insurance company they are insured with.

The care counselling ...

- provides assistance with the application process and the assessment procedure by the Medical Service of the health insurance funds
- **informs** about the organisation and Financing care
- provides guidance on the various support options for people in need of care and their relatives

- informs carers about relief options
- advises people on the clinical picture of dementia, contact points for diagnosis and treatment, care services and care insurance benefits.

Living counselling

These are often only minor housing defects, that severely impair the daily routine of elderly people, people in need of care or people with a disability. They can often be eliminated with simple solutions.

During a home visit, the housing counselling staff work with those affected to develop suggestions for a barrier-free redesign of the home. This supports independent living in familiar surroundings for as long as possible.



The house counselling ...

- advises on the selection of everyday aids and technical aids
- helps with changes to the furnishings in the home (e.g. orientation aids, furniture increases)
- offers support for new builds and conversions
- and provides information on financing and application.

Outreach counselling and support

The outreach counselling and support staff act as help managers for people who are in need of help or care.

In particular, people who live alone, without relatives, neighbours or friends receive support.

Outreach counselling and support ...

- assists with applications for social benefits
- organises, for example, a care service, home emergency call, meal service, home help

Support is usually provided in the form of home visits and ends when care at home is assured.

This practical support enables many people to continue living independently in their familiar home environment. Moving into a care home can be postponed or even avoided.
